Melbourne Drinking Water Supplies

Do you know what toxic chemicals the Government of Victoria force-feeds you every day through your kitchen tap?

None of the following chemical additives in your drinking water are pharmaceutical quality - they are crude industrial grade.

The fluoride chemical fed into the water is a waste by-product poison pollutant, collected from fertilizer factory exhaust chimneys, not permitted in their final product, superphosphate - it is too toxic for farms but profitably sold for human consumption.

The following chemicals are purposely added to Melbourne's drinking water supplies each year:

Fluoride	1030 tonnes per annum
Lime	2070 tonnes per annum
Alum, Aluminium Sulphate	1750 tonnes per annum
Chlorine	550 tonnes per annum
Sodium Hydrochloride	250 tonnes per annum
Ammonia	8 kilolitres per annum
